**Date:** **November 19-23, 2014**  
**Venue:** **Provincial Capitol Complex, Alabel, Sarangani Province**  
**Theme:** **“Environment and Development through Scouting”**

**Participants:** a. KID/KAB Scouts  
b. Boy Scouts  
c. Senior/Rover Scouts  
d. Adults/Teacher

Each District/School is encouraged to organize and send a minimum of Two (2) Troops (64 Scouts) per section (KAB/KID, BOY, SENIOR/ROVER).

**Qualifications:** a. **Scouts**-must be currently registered KID/KAB/BOY/SENIOR/ROVER SCOUTS

- must be physically fit as certified by a physician/district nurse

b. **Adults**- must be duly registered with the BSP

- must be of good moral character

- must be physically fit as certified by a physician/district nurse.

- must have camping experienced and scouting knowledge.

**Registration Fee:** A Jamborette registration fee of Three Hundred Pesos (Php 300.00) shall be collected from each participant to cover the cost of activity materials, administrative requirements and Jamborette items.

**Requirements:** Individual Application and Health Form, Parents Consent, Medical Certificate.
