

1. The Department of Education Region XII, through the Health and Nutrition Unit and Regional EPP and TLE Coordinators and the Department of Agriculture XII, announces the *Regionwide Search for Outstanding Implementors of the Agri-Pinoy Gulayan sa Paaralan 2013*.

2. The search will be conducted from September 2013 to December 2013, and the implementation will start on September 2013 to all public elementary and secondary schools to support the Hunger Mitigation initiatives of the government and DepEd Memo No. 293 series 2007.

3. Agri-Pinoy Gulayan sa Paaralan Program is under the umbrella of the National Greening Program of the government promoting the production of foods rich in protein, carbohydrates, Vit A and iron. School gardens serve as sources of vegetables for the school supplementary feeding program encouraging school aged children to engage in simple food production activities and promote consumption of vegetables. Preferred vegetables to help address malnutrition problems in schools are the following: a) leguminous vegetables, beans, mungo, peas etc., b) sources of calorie/energy – root crops such as gabi, camote, cassava etc., c) sources of vitamin A and iron – leafy green vegetables, tops of gabi, melunggay, saluyod, aluhat, kangkong, sit, kulits, pechay etc.

4. Winners will be announced after the regional evaluation on November 2013 through a Regional Memorandum. Cash prizes and certificates will be given by the Department of Education Region XII and garden tools and goods (drums, organic fertilizers etc.) will be given by the Department of Agriculture XII to the following winners:
