1. TUKLAS KATUTUBO, Inc, a National Organization of Tribal Leaders and Advocates of the Philippines- Sarangani Chapter, is a non-profit SEC registered organization led by Indigenous Peoples coming from farmers, students, youth, folks, Filipino society, teachers and other professions, which aims to empower the indigenous communities to be active, organized, productive, and assertive facing the mainstream.
2. In this connection and as per letter (dated September 13, 2013) by Datu Benedicto T. Angonia, president of TUKLAS KATUTUBO, Inc, they will be conducting a **“Creative Pedagogy Training for IP Teachers on the Contextualization of IP Curriculum”** on September 22-25, 2013 at Sydney Hotel, General Santos City. This is a Free Live-in Seminar and therefore, NO REGISTRATION.
3. The training intentionally designed to enhance and develop the knowledge, skills and attitude (KSA) in the integration of IP curriculum in their teaching profession. In particular, the objectives of the training are the following:
  - a. learn basic information, overview, essential components and principles of MTB-MLE;
  - b. capacitate teachers on the contextualization and development of IMs for IP Curriculum;
  - c. learn IPRA Law;
  - d. adopt MTB-MLE in the lesson plan/session in their respective languages; and
  - e. appreciate the MTB-MLE as a medium of instruction.
4. Participants are advised to bring video clips and print out of indigenous knowledge, skills and practices (songs, rituals, stories, instruments, foods, sports, livelihood, costumes, myths and others) during the training, and the copies of Teachers’ Guide for elementary and secondary.
5. School heads are advised to assign their remaining teachers to take-charge of the classes of the participants while they are on the training, to assure no disruption of classes, as per measure to strengthen Engaged Time-On-Task.
