Date : October 30, 2013

1. The Training / Retooling for IP school heads and teachers is being organized to help IP teachers and schools heads develop knowledge, skills and attitudes needed to support the policy directives of DepED Order No. 62, s. 2011 (The National IP Education Policy Framework) and the vision of a culture-responsive and relevant K to 12 curriculum.
2. This two-day live- in training will be conducted on **November 8-9, 2013 at the Family Country Hotel, Mateo Road, Lagao, General Santos City.**
3. The Training aims to: (a) develop a holistic perspective on the overall learning and socio cultural context of IP communities; (b) gain and develop a new set of skills related to research, teaching approaches, techniques, and development of learning tools that will help them be effective and efficient teachers /school heads of schools serving IP communities; (c) commit to a conscious effort of engagement aligned with the principles and policy statement outlined in the National IP Education Policy Framework (DEPED Order no. 62,s .2011) through the preparation of a re-entry action plan for SY 2013-2014.

 8. All District Heads and identified secondary/integrated school heads are requested to submit the name/s of recommended IP teacher-participant/s on or before **November 6, 2013** via text message to ASDS Estacio and Mrs. Camela Naive.
 9. IP Participants are requested to bring their IP Costumes for documentation and program ritual purposes.
 10. The registration fee is free chargeable against IPEd Funds, however, traveling expenses of the participants are chargeable against MOOE / local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations
