ON EDUKASYON SA PAGPAPAKATAO

The *Pambansang Samahan Para sa Edukasyon sa Pagpapahalaga* (PSEP), Inc. will conduct its 23rd Annual National Convention and 2nd Seminar-Workshop on *Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao* (EsP) with the theme *Ang Unang Dalawang Taon ng EsP sa K to 12 Curriculum: Isang Pagtataya* from November 29 to December 1, 2013 at the Venus Parkview Hotel, Baguio City.

The Convention and Seminar-Workshop aim to:

1. gather feedback on the first two years of implementation of the EsP Program in the K to 12 or Enhanced Basic Education Curriculum ;
2. explore ways or possible solutions which will address issues arising from the initial implementation of the EsP Program; and
3. enhance the capabilities of the EsP teachers in teaching the subject.

The awarding of the winners of the 2013 PSEP Search for Outstanding School-Based VE/EP/EsP Program and Outstanding VE Educator as well as the 2013 National *Tagis Talino*, Poster-Making and *Sayawit* Contests in VE/EP/EsP will also be held on said dates.

The target participants to these activities are the students, teachers, principals, supervisors, department heads, coordinators from both public and private elementary and secondary schools.
