1. The 2014 Sarangani Provincial Athletic Meet shall be held on September 24-27, 2014 in Glan Sports Complex, Glan, Sarangani Province to be hosted by the Central, South and North Districts and the Municipality of Glan assisted by the Provincial Government and DepEd Sarangani. The theme for this year's celebration "**Sports is a way of life.**"
2. The objectives of the meet are to:
  - a. promote Physical Education (PE) and Sports as an integral part of the Basic Education for holistic development of the youth to become responsible and globally competitive;
  - b. inculcate the spirit of discipline, teamwork, excellence, fair play, solidarity, sportsmanship, and other values inherent in sports
  - c. promote and achieve peace by means of sports;
  - d. widen the base for talent identification, selection, recruitment, training and exposure of elementary pupils and secondary secondary students to serve as a feeder to the National Sports Associations (NSA) for international competitions; and
  - e. provide a database for a valid and universal basis to further improve the school sports development programs
3. To ensure the effective and efficient conduct of the SPAA Meet, the following enclosures are attached:
  - General Guidelines
  - Calendar of Activities
  - Participating Delegations, Billeting Quarters and Playing Venues
  - Lists of Events, Number of Athletes, Coaches and Chaperons
4. It is requested that all delegations must bring their own sports equipment.

## **General Guidelines**

### **Rules on Participation**

#### **1. Participants**

- 1.1 Participants in the SPAA shall be elementary and secondary athletes from public and private schools who participated in the lower meets (Intramurals, School, District, Municipal)
- 1.2 Must be registered in the Boys And Girls Scouts of the Philippines or Philippine National Red Cross (PNRC)

#### **2. Eligibility of Athletes**

To be eligible as participant in the SPAA meet, an athlete must be

- 2.1 A Filipino Citizen;
- 2.2 Enrolled in a recognized school at the beginning of the current school year and attended and finished the curriculum year;
- 2.3 Should have participated in the preliminary meets;
- 2.4 For elementary athlete, he or she should have been born in **2002** or after; and for secondary athletes he or she should have been born in **1997** or after. Thereafter, add one (1) year to the cut-off date for succeeding year.
- 2.5 Pupil/student- athletes who transferred from one region to another are allowed to participate, provided their transfer was done at the beginning of the school year. Transferees from one division to another within the region are allowed to participate, provided they have participated in the lower meets.
- 2.6 As a general rule, Elementary athletes shall play in the elementary division, secondary athletes shall play in the secondary division. However elementary athletes who have been declared over-age in the elementary level may be allowed to play in the secondary level.

#### **3. Grounds for Disqualification** – The following shall not be allowed to play in the SPAA meet:

- 3.1 Athletes who have been declared over-age ;
- 3.2 Elementary athletes with 3<sup>rd</sup> molar tooth;
- 3.3 Athletes with failing grades in more than two (2) core subjects in the second grading period
- 3.4 Athletes who become or has been a member of the National Team, National Training and National Developmental Pool, receiving monthly stipend/allowance from the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) ; played in SEA GAMES. ASIAN GAMES and/or Olympic Games. Provided, however, that those athletes who played in foreign invitational competition not included in the above mentioned games shall not be disqualified to play in the Palarong Pambansa.
- 3.5 Athletes who failed to submit the required documents or failed to submit oneself for personal interview on the specified time.
- 3.6 Banned during the previous Palarong Pambansa.

#### **4. Documents to be submitted During Screening**

- 4.1 Athlete's Record signed by the athlete, coach, and PESS Division Supervisor

- 4.2 Original and photocopy of Birth Certificate issued by the National Statistics Office (NSO). Late registration may be accepted, provided that it was issued one (1) Year prior to current Palarong Pambansa.
  - 4.2.1 In the case of a foreign-born Filipino athlete, in lieu of NSO Birth Certificate, the original birth certificate issued by the country of his/her birth certificate and a valid passport or a document issued by the Bureau of Immigration/Department of Foreign Affairs, showing his/her nationality as a Filipino.
  - 4.2.2 Those athletes who qualified in the last two Palarong Pambansa shall not be required to submit copy of the original Birth Certificate from NSO.
- 4.3 Form 137, certified true copy from original or computer printed, duly prepared and signed by the Teacher-Adviser, with fresh signatures of the registrar/Principal/ School Heads, and by the Division PESS Supervisor.
  - 4.3.1 In case the rating in the second grading period are not indicated in the Form -137 of the athlete, the certified true copy of Form -138 (Report Card) Shall be submitted
  - 4.3.2 In cases of athletes who are enrolled under the Alternative Delivery Mode (Home Study Program/ Open high school Program), a copy of the numerical/ Descriptive rating equivalent to the second grading period of the regular classes should be submitted.
  - 4.3.3 In cases of athletes who are enrolled in school under a trimester program, shall submit a certified copies of their grades for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> quarters
- 4.4 Certification of Completion duly signed by the School Registrar or the School Head.
- 4.5 Parent's or guardian's consent, verified by the Principal/Registrar/Teacher/Adviser
- 4.6 Medical Certificate, signed by a physician, stating that the athlete is physically fit and within the age limit required, with a validity of three (3) months from the date of issue. The complete name of the signing physician shall clearly appear on the medical certificate, with the license number and date of examination.)
- 4.7 Dental Certificate with a universal entry, duly signed by a dentist over his/her clearly printed name and license number, and with the date of examination which should not be more than six (6) months prior to the date of the opening of the Palarong Pambansa.
- 4.8 Four (4) passport size 1 1/2 x 1 1/2 identical pictures with name tag(surname, first name and middle initial) and grade/year level, to be used for the athlete's Record, medical/dental certificate, gallery and Palarong Pambansa Accreditation Card.
- 4.9 List of athlete's indicating the date of birth, division, school and name of their coach, duly signed by the regional Director, soft (diskette, USB or any other media) and Hard (printed) copy.
- 4.10 Affidavit of the coach, attesting the authenticity, validity and correctness of the entries on the above-mentioned documents submitted.

## **5. Eligibility of Coaches and Chaperons**

- 5.1 Coaches and chaperons must be school or DepEd personnel. Coaches and chaperons from private schools must have been in the service for at least six (6) months. Female athletes shall only be assisted by a female chaperon.
- 5.2 Documents to be submitted:
  - 5.2.1 Certificate of Employment ( certified true copy of the original document and duly Notarized);

5.2.2 Form 212 with three(3) ID pictures
